Any action contrary to this provision taken by the institute will make it liable to be derecognised.

Further in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the norms & standards prescribed by the AICTE by December of last approved academic year, the Council shall take further action to withdraw approval to these cases for admission during subsequent academic year and the liability arising out of such withdrawal of approval will be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions. AICTE may inspect the institution at any time it may deem fit to note its progress.



MORADABAD INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, MORADABAD, U.P.

1. One Head of Department having qualifications and experience as prescribed by the AICTE, should be in position in each discipline prior to the admission of the students.
2. The teaching faculty should be brought at par with AICTE norms by way of recruitment of senior faculty and adequate number of lecturers maintaining the cadre proportion so as to bring it at par with AICTE norms.
3. The institute should take immediate steps for making the new building operational and shift into the same prior admission.
