Item No.2 Action taken on the minutes of IQAC meeting held on 19th February, 2020 were reported and noted with the following observation:-

(i) Analysis of Feedback from faculty and students

As regular classes have been suspended after 14th March, 2020 onwards due to COVID-19 pandemic, it is discussed and suggested that online feedback on a prescribed format may be taken from the students.

(ii) Approval process of new course.

We have already obtained approval from AICTE for the current Academic Session 2021 with the addition/change of the course/programme/ intake.

- a) New branch of B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering in Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning with an intake of 30 seats.
- b) New specialization in B.Voc i.e. Graphics and Multimedia in place of Production Technology with an intake of 30 seats.
- c) Surrendered 30 seats of MBA programme in MIT-082
- d) B.Voc. in Interior Design with an intake of 30 seats in MET FOA.

(iii) Status of NAAC

Online application has been filed. Replies of queries have been submitted online along with relevant attachments.

Status of NBA

Institute will apply for NBA in the department of Mechanical Engineering, and Computer Science & Engineering. Preparation of NBA report is in progress and all the departments will complete it before the end of September 2020.

Item No.3: Academic Planning of Odd Semester 2020-21.

- a) Academic activities of the Even Semester 2019-20 are completed. Sessional Marks have been compiled and uploaded on AKTU portal.
- b) All HODs are suggested to work out the load for the session 2020-21. Also plan for conduction of classes, mode of teaching, conduction of practicals, examinations etc in the session 2020-21 in view of the current pandemic situation.

- 2. All HODs are suggested to inform their students about online training during semester break. HODs and faculty members should provide all possible help to their students in this regard.
