3. NPTEL

The National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) was initiated by seven Indian Institutes of Technology (Bombay, Delhi, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, Guwahati and Roorkee) along with the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 2003. Five core disciplines were identified, namely, civil engineering, computer science and engineering, electrical engineering, electronics and communication engineering and mechanical engineering and 235 courses in web/video format were developed in this phase.

The main goal of NPTEL Phase II (2009-14) was to build on the engineering and core science courses launched previously in NPTEL Phase I. An

additional 600 web and video courses were created in all major branches of engineering, physical sciences at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels and management courses at the postgraduate level. Several improvements such as indexing of all video and web courses and keyword search were implemented. NPTEL began offering open online courses in March 2014 along with certificates from the IITs/IISc for those who completed the courses successfully. As of now NPTEL has become the largest online repository in the world of courses in engineering, basic sciences and selected humanities and social sciences subjects.

In the direction of Prof. (Dr.) B. P. Singh, NPTEL local chapter was instituted in MIT before the university initiative in January 2018. And since then we have constantly been making faculty members and students aware about these courses, the result of this is that till today we have 272 candidates who have completed different courses successfully of which 18 are Gold/ Topper certificates. In the current semester total 99 candidates (75 students + 14 faculty members) are registered in different courses for examination whose result will finalized till May last. Many students are using these to prepare for GATE exams and higher studies too.

If we look at recent development, MIT administration is also thinking about giving financial benefits through motivational schemes to the students which will prove to be very effective in raising the number of registration in these courses.
