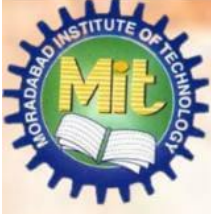

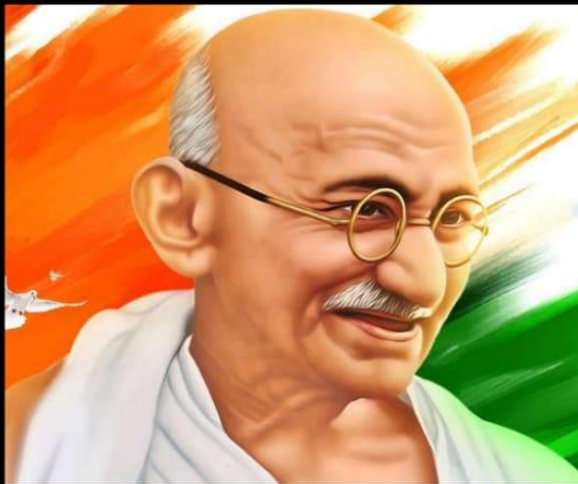

The main aim of the event was to make student enhance their memory skills and to learn how to achieve their targets within the limited time. There were 94 participants in this event.

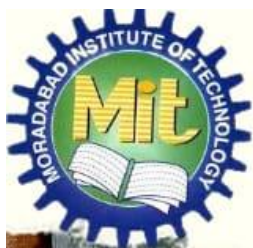
