The main goal of the Intellitool workshop was to introduce students to the practical applications of Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools and empower them to use these tools effectively in real-world scenarios, academic projects, and professional settings.

Mr. Inayat Ullah Khan, the lead trainer and AI expert, conducted an interactive and insightful session. He introduced students to modern AI tools such as ChatGPT, Gemini, DALL·E, Notion AI, Runway ML, GitHub Copilot, and Perplexity AI. He demonstrated how these tools can be used for idea generation, content creation, image generation, code writing, debugging, optimizing, and conducting AI-assisted research. Real-life examples and practical use-cases were discussed to show how students can use these tools to solve problems and enhance productivity.

Mr. Khan also provided step-by-step guidance on how to build a complete AI-based project—from idea generation to execution. He elaborated on tool selection, data handling, output analysis, and techniques for effective presentation. The session was both technically enriching and highly motivational.
